
T4T Lesson 1 - Assurance of Salvation (Spiritual Birth)

I. We Were Cut Off from God

What is the result of sin? Isaiah 59:2 says:

"It's your sins that have cut you off from God. Because of your sins, he has turned away and will not listen anymore."



II. Way of Salvation

Jesus Death + Faith + Repentance = Salvation



Jesus Death: Romans 4:25 says "He was handed over to die because of our sins, and he was raised to life to make us right with God."

Faith: Acts 16:31 says "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved."

Repentance: 1 John 1:9 says "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and will forgive us." Has God done his part to save you (death and resurrection)? Yes or No Have you done your part (believe and repent)? Yes or No If you believed, then you are saved!

III. You are a New Creation

"If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come!" - 2 Corinthians 5:17 What changes have you experienced after believing in Jesus?

IV. Am I still saved?

1 John 1:9 says "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and will forgive us."

But if we keep on purposefully sinning without asking for forgiveness our sins won't be forgiven. Hebrews 10:26 says "If we purposefully sin after we know the truth, there is no more sacrifice to cover that sin."

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

T4T Lesson 2 - Understanding Prayer (Spiritual Breathing)

When a baby is born they need to breathe. Prayer is like learning to breathe in your new spiritual life. Prayer is talking to God.



I. Why should we pray?

- A. It is God's command. Jesus told his disciples to always pray and never give up.
- B. It develops our Relationship with God the Father. Prayer is Giving and Receiving.

We give God:

- praise
- love
- problems
- sin

God gives us:

- peace
- hope
- forgiveness
- answers



Philippians 4:6-7 "Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and petition with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God which passes all understanding will quard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus."

II. How to pray (Attitudes of prayer) - Use actions to remember these.

Pray with Faith. Don't doubt - James 1:6 (point at head)

"But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind."



Pray with a clean Heart. Check Your Heart (confess sin & check your motives) - James 4:2-3 (point at heart)



"You do not have because you do not ask God. When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures."

Pray for God's will with confidence. 1 John 5:14-15 (**Point upward**)



"This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him."

Keep asking. Don't give up. Luke 18:1 – 8 (Shake hands to indicate repeating)



Tell the story from Luke 18:1 - 8

III. Hints for Effective Prayer

- Pray in Jesus' name
- Pray naturally, like talking to a friend
- Pray any time of the day
- Pray anywhere

T4T Lesson 3 - Daily Devotions (Spiritual Food)

Reading the Bible and worshipping daily is how we get our spiritual food. To have a close relationship with God you need give time to Him every day at a set time.

- To become strong in our spiritual lives (we obey and grow)



T4T Lesson 4 - The Church (Your Spiritual Family)


I. Family

When you start to follow Jesus, you become a member of God's family. God is like your heavenly Father and all other believers in Jesus are like your brothers and sisters. The Bible calls this spiritual family the church. The church is not a building or place of worship, it is a group of believers.

IV. 3 Responsibilities of the Church (Body of Christ)

1. Baptism

Romans 6:4 "We died and were buried with Christ by baptism. Just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glorious power of the Father, now we also may live new lives."

- Baptism is our how we show our unity with Jesus. Jesus was baptized as an example for us.
 We also must be baptized.
- Baptism fulfills our faith.
- Baptism **proclaims** our faith.
- Baptism **confirms** our faith
- Baptism is a witness and symbol of our faith.
- Baptism is a command and important step for every disciple to take.



2. Lord's Supper

Jesus taught his disciples to celebrate the Lord's supper (Matt 26:17-19, 26-30)





It helps us to remember to thank God for his death and forgiveness. It helps us to examine our actions and faith (1 Cor 11:23-29)

- 3. **Giving to God** Time, Money, talents
- Offerings (Thank you gifts to God as worship)
- Tithes (10% we are required to give to God)
 Malachi 3:8-10 "Do not rob God. Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse."

T4T Lesson 5 - God our Heavenly Father

A new spiritual child needs to understand who is in charge of the family. They need to get to know their Heavenly Father. The Heavenly Father loves, protects, provides for and trains His children.



There are many stories in the Bible of the Heavenly Father's character. This lesson will begin to introduce you to some of these.



I. The Heavenly Father's Love
Jeremiah 31:3 says that God loves you with an everlasting love!
Luke 15:11-24 Tells a beautiful story about a Father and his

II. The Heavenly Father's **Protection**The book of Daniel in the Old Testament tells a story of three God followers who were protected by their Father in Heaven. (Daniel chapter 3)

III. The Heavenly Father's **Provision**Philippians 4:19 says, "And my God will supply all of your needs according to his glorious riches in Christ Jesus."

Matt 14:13-21 Tells a story of a time when Jesus provided supernaturally for people who were hungry.

Can God also provide for you?

IV. The Heavenly Father's **Discipline** and **Training**

Hebrews 12:6 "The Lord disciplines those He loves, and He punishes each one he accepts as His child."



God expects us to obey Him. When we disobey, he disciplines us through friends, the Bible, and allowing trials and consequences of our sin to come in our lives.

T4T Lesson 6 - Spreading the Gospel (Giving Back to the Family)

Now you are a member of God's family, the church. You need to give back to the family. God calls you to spread the gospel and teach new believers to obey all His ways. Then they can teach even more people about the good news of salvation and then train them also.



There are four types of calls to share the gospel:



1. Call from Above - from Heaven

The King commands us to go to those who haven't heard of His salvation.

"Go into all the world and preach the gospel to everyone." Mark 16:15

2. Call from Below - from Hell Luke 16:27-28 Story of Rich Man in hell





3. Call from Inside our own heart

Paul felt compelled to spread the good news

"For if I preach the gospel, I have no reason for boasting, because I am compelled to do this. Woe to me if I do not preach the gospel!" 1 Cor 9:16

4. Call from Outside - lost people around us


Acts 16:9 Paul heard a call in a dream from the man of Macedonia.
